

Kit for making washing powder

- 300 g Marseille soap (flakes already grated)
- 2 kg sodium carbonate (soda ash)
- 50 ml essential oil
- 1 kg sodium pecarbonate
- 50 g TAED

How do you make your detergent for coloured clothes?

Mix 300g of grated soap and 2kg of sodium carbonate. Put the mixture in a suitable container and store it.

How do you make your laundry detergent?

Mix 1 to 2 tablespoons of sodium pecarbonate and 1 to 2 teaspoons of DAT. The DAT activates the product if you wash it at temperatures below 60°C. If you wash at temperatures above 60°C, there is no need to use DAT.

Detergent dosage:

Coloured laundry:

2-3 tablespoons (a mixture of soap and carbonate) directly into the washing drum.

White laundry:

2-3 tablespoons (a mixture of soap and carbonate) directly into the washing drum + 2 tablespoons (sodium pecarbonate and TAED).

WARNING!!! THE MIXTURE OF PECARBONATE AND TAED CAUSES THE LAUNDRY TO FOAM. NEVER MIX MORE TAED AND PECARBONATE THAN NECESSARY.

Softener:

Mix 2 teaspoons of vinegar with water (add as much water as you normally use for fabric softener) and add a few drops of orange fragrance.
